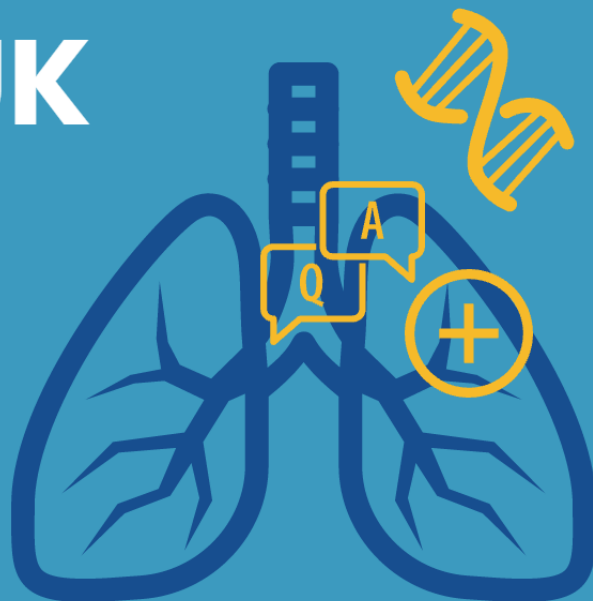


ALK POSITIVE UK

ALK positive is a relatively rare form of lung cancer caused by the abnormal rearrangement of the anaplastic lymphoma kinase gene. Founded in 2018, ALK Positive UK's fundamental aim is to provide support to patients and their families, raise awareness and contribute to research.

4% of lung cancer patients are diagnosed with ALK Positive

That's approximately 3,400 patients in the UK

There are approximately 85,000 living with lung cancer in the UK
